WHAT

WHAT TOPICS DOES THIS COURSE COVER?

This online course helps participants understanding why gender equality matters and why there's a need of change, particularly in the post Covid19 time. It offers gender-centered strategies and tools to promote equality and decent work for all in order to make change happen!

WHAT WILL I LEARN?

Participants will practice skills in a 5-week intensive learning experience, which includes online learning and virtual discussions, live teaching and online mentoring.

Key topics are:

- Structural inequalities in the world of work
- The international framework for gender equality and the United Nations' system-wide strategy
- Gender and organizational change: obstacles within organizations and how to overcome them
- How to create an online community of practice that fosters discussion and knowledge-sharing at distance
- Good practices, strategies and tools to lead the change in the new Era

WHAT WILL I BE ABLE TO DO?

The goal of this course is to help participants deepen their knowledge of gender matters and practice gender mainstreaming skills customized to the virtual needs and challenges of the new Era.

- Apply appropriate gender mainstreaming tools in any workplace, anywhere in the world
- Utilize advanced skills in advocacy and communication to spread messages
- Access a global UN community of practice for discussion and knowledge-sharing

WITHDRAWAL, CANCELLATION POLICY, AND REFUNDS FOR OPEN COURSES

If an enrolled participant wishes or must withdraw from a course, they may choose to apply to a different course or be substituted by another candidate. The participant must notify the Centre, in writing, of their decision at least 14 days prior to the start date of the course. Cancellation of participation in regular courses will result in the following penalties:

- 14 days or more prior to the start date of the course: No penalty, 100% refund of amount paid less applicable bank charges
- 8 to 13 days prior to the start date of the course: Penalty of 50% of course price, refund of residual amount paid (if any) less applicable bank charges
- 7 days or less prior to the start date of the course: Penalty of 100% of course price.
